The petitioners have sought writ in the nature of mandamus by approaching this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, directing the respondents to provide unobstructed passage to Shamshan Ghat (cremation ground) to the residents of village Samaspur, Sector-51, Gurugram, which is in existence in Khasra No.34 since 1964. Further prayer has been made restraining the respondents to construct over passage on Plot No.714, Sector-51, Gurugram.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, submitted that the petitioner may be permitted to file a detailed and comprehensive representation for redressal of his grievance as sought to be raised in this petition with respondent No.4 and it was prayed that a time bound direction be issued to the said respondent to decide the same by passing a speaking order.

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3. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, perusing the writ petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of controversy, we dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation for redressal of his grievance as sought to be raised in this writ petition before respondent No.4 within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is further directed that in case any such representation is filed, the respondent shall decide the same within next two months from the date of receipt of same, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, in accordance with law.
