Petitioners are seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to hand over the charge of Gurdwara Sahib Padshahi Naumi, Ganduan, to them after taking the same from respondent No.6.

It is stated in the petition that petitioner No.1 is the president and petitioner Nos.2 to 4 are members of the Parbandhak Committee, which has been constituted to look after the affairs of aforesaid Gurdwara Sahib. Vide order dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, petitioners were restrained from doing any work in respect of the Gurdwara Sahib. Respondent No.6 was appointed as receiver for the betterment of the Gurdwara Sahib and its property till further order. The said order was challenged by the petitioners by filing Civil Revision No.3947 of 2018, wherein while issuing notice of motion on 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-3), operation of the order dated 17.05.2018 was stayed by this Court.

of the order dated 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-3), respondent No.6 is not handing over the charge of Gurdwara Sahib to the petitioners. Even, on an application made by the petitioners, SGPC has approached the Commission vide letter dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-9) to take action in this regard.

At this stage, the present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Chairman, Sikh Gurdwara Judicial Commission, Amritsar, to look into the letter/application dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-9) sent by the SGPC and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within a period of two weeks.
