KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (Oral)

Respondent No.2 floated a notice inviting tender for providing manpower services on contract basis under outsourcing policy. Petitioner was also one of the tenderer. The financial bid of petitioner has been rejected on the ground that he has put a zero after decimal in the rates quoted though the tender notice contained a specific condition in the necessary notes that zero after decimal will not be accepted.

Petitioner does not deny that he violated this condition. The reason supplied to him for rejecting the tender also states that since he has put zero after decimal and thereby violated the condition of the tender notice, his tender has been rejected. We see no infirmity and illegality in the impugned action taken by the respondent in rejecting the tender of the petitioner as it violated the mandatory terms and conditions contained in the tender notice. It is also pointed out that other two tenderers who had

committed same mistake, their claims have also been rejected. In such circumstances, we do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned action of the respondent and the petition is devoid of merit and accordingly stands dismissed.
