JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners, nine in number, are employed as 'Pharmacists' with the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab. They have challenged the orders dated 17.04.2018 and 05.06.2018 (**Annexures P-3/colly & P-4 respectively**), whereby the Government has deployed doctors and para-medical staff including the 'Pharmacists' for intermittent spells between the period w.e.f. 25.06.2018 till 28.08.2018 for the benefit of pilgrims (worshippers) undertaking the '*Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra*'.

The grievance of the petitioners is that some of them are on the higher side of the middle age, and are being deployed without keeping in view their individual medical conditions.

After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition, so as to make a representation before the quarter concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
