The petitioner has come up in writ petition for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus to consider the claim of the petitioners for appointment as Assistant Engineer (Civil) against the quota meant for ex-service/dependent of Ex.Servicemen remained vacant due to the reasons that the private respondents No.3 to 8 were not found eligible for appointment from the date other batch mates have been appointed and petitioner be granted all benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that out of 10 recommended candidates for the post of A.E.(Civil), six candidates i.e. respondents No.3 to 8 were not found eligible after their examination. He further submits that petitioners who are dependent of Ex-Servicemen and next in order of merit and if, respondent/Commission would not have considered the claim of the private respondents No.3 to 8 then they should have been allowed to join for the same posts. He further submits that petitioners served final demand notice and request was made that if their

no alternative except to approach to this Court but respondents have not given any response in the matter.

Keeping in view the notification Annexure R-16/1 dated 23.03.2016, present writ petition is allowed and a direction is being given to respondent No.1 to look into the representation Annexure P-8 and pass appropriate orders within four weeks from the date of receiving of certified copy of this Order.
