The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for quashing the notices dated 7.5.2018 (Annexure P-5 colly). Issued by respondent No.3 under Section 26(2) of the Control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act, 2002, vide which the petitioners have been directed to remove the alleged unauthorised occupation of the highway land on National Highway No.44.

Reply on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record. In the reply, it has been mentioned that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners were heard and a fresh demarcation has been carried out and a

fresh report has been prepared on 24.7.2018.

In view of the above, the intended purpose of filing of the present petition stands achieved and the Court is satisfied with regard to the veracity of the report. The respondents are directed to take necessary steps to execute the work in terms of the report dated 24.7.2018.
