Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that before coming to this Court, the petitioner has also filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 23711 of 2017 before this Court in which the following order has been passed: -

“In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners in terms of whatever be the prevailing position of law today after considering the effect of the order passed by the Supreme Court.”

It is submitted that thereafter, no order has been passed by the respondents, therefore, present petition has been filed again for seeking a direction.

I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner cannot seek the same directions time and again specially when there is a direction issued by this Court already in his favour to decide his claim. Thus, the remedy would lie in the contempt petition instead of filing of writ petition.

Faced with these observations, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail remedy of filing contempt petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
Liberty granted.
