The grievance of the petitioner is that she is not being permitted to join back with MARKFED although she has been permitted to join the inquiry proceedings qua her for being remained absent from duty and having proceeded abroad in violation of the condition of the sanctioned leave.

On the directions of this Court, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi, Additional Advocate General, Punjab had put in appearance on behalf of the MARKFED on the previous date of hearing i.e. on 18.07.2018.

The Court had impressed upon the Counsel for directing the MARKFED to permit the petitioner to join her duties pending departmental inquiry with regard to willful absence from duty.

At the time of hearing, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi, Additional

addressed to him by the MARKFED along with an order whereby petitioner has been permitted to join her duties without prejudice to the pending departmental inquiry.

Mr. Shiv Kumar, Advocate for the petitioner in response states that the present writ petition has become infructuous as her client has since joined on 24.7.2018 itself.

In view of the above, no further adjudication is required and resultantlly the present petition is hereby dismissed.
