Learned counsel for the petitioner states that claim of the petitioner is only in respect of the interest on the delayed payment. He further states that for the claim made in the writ petition, he has already filed a representation Annexure P-7 dated 03.04.2018 and a reminder given on 17.05.2018 which are still pending consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a direction is given to the respondents to decide his representation (Annexure P-7) dated 03.04.2018 in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection for the same.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representation Annexure P-7 dated 03.04.2018 within a period of three months. In case, after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the interest, the same should also be released to him within next three months.

It is made clear that this Court express no opinion upon the entitlement of the petitioner, at this stage.
