The petitioners are owners in possession of land measuring 10 kanals, fully described in para No.4 of the writ petition, situated within the revenue estate of Patti Kaisth Seth, Tehsil and District Kaithal. The aforementioned land alongwith a chunk of land was sought to be acquired vide notifications dated 12.09.2008 and 05.06.2009 issued under Sections 4 & 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, respectively. However, the petitioners' land was decided to be released from acquisition before passing the Award. Later on, the State Government vide the impugned communication dated 27.01.2016 has conveyed to the Director General of Police, Haryana, with reference to the decision of this Court rendered in CWP No.9213 of 2011 (Roop Chand and others versus State of Haryana and others) and connected cases, that the State Government has agreed with the report of the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal and has decided to acquire the land measuring 123 kanal 3 marla, which was earlier decided to be released on 15.09.2010.

As of now, no acquisition process has been started. The

petitioners, in our considered view, will be at liberty to raise all their contentions including those taken in the instant writ petition, as and when the State Government takes steps to acquire their land. Their objections shall firstly be considered by the Land Acquisition Collector/Competent Authority in accordance with law and if still dissatisfied, the petitioners may approach any forum including this Court.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition is disposed of at this stage.
