AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the order dated 30.5.2017, Annexure P.8, whereby respondent No.4 dismissed the securitization application. A further challenge is to the order dated 1.11.2017, Annexure P.9, dismissing the application for recalling the order dated 30.5.2017 and also the challenge to the order dated 30.11.2017, Annexure P.10, whereby the Appellate Tribunal imposed a condition for pre-deposit of 25% amount of debt.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently all the relevant documents could not be annexed with the present petition. Accordingly, learned counsel prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with

liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
