By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to grant initial of regular pay scale to the petitioners equivalent to other regular appointed employees of the corresponding categories along with usual allowances, in pursuance of Annexures P-1 to P-3.

Learned counsel states, at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondents No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) in the light of the judgment dated 26.10.2016, passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **State of Punjab and others** Vs. **Jagjit Singh and others**, Civil Appeal 213 of 2013 (Annexure P-3). He further states that, at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the competent authority is directed to consider and decide the case of the petitioner(s) in the light of above said judgment, within a specified time.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the assertion raised by learned counsel for the petitioner(s).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s)-State to consider the case of the petitioner(s) in the light of assertion made. If, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioners is at par with the petitioners in the above said judgments, the competent authority is directed to pass the consequential order within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
