JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (*Sukhjinder Pal Singh*) was appointed as “Constable” vide order dated 13.06.2009 (**Annexure P-3**) on compassionate basis on account of death of his father on 22.02.2007.

The petitioner claims that he was 10+2 class passed at the time of joining, however, having subsequently graduated in the year 2010, is claiming appointment as “Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI)” on compassionate basis. Consequently, he has also sought the quashing of his appointment order dated 13.06.2009 (**P-3**) as “Constable”.

Out of six (06) dates, on which the case has been listed, counsel for the petitioner has appeared only once and sought adjournment. Since last three (03) consecutive dates, no one has bothered to appear, therefore, present petition is liable to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
