Petitioner (Lakhbir Singh) was an aspirant for recruitment to the post of 'Pharmacists' advertised in the year 2014 by the National Health Mission Punjab. The written test for selection was conducted on 25.05.2014 by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot. The petitioner is stated to have sent a memo dated 13.05.2015 (**Annexure P-6**) with regard to furnishing of false information under the RTI Act, 2005, to the effect that the answer keys to the some of the stated questions were wrong, however, the stated answer keys were adopted as correct.

By filing the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking a direction for rechecking the answer sheet(s) of the written test held on 25.05.2014 from an independent authority.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, no ground for invoking the writ jurisdiction is made out.

The petitioner was declared unsuccessful in June 2014, and concededly, the appointments also stand made to the advertised posts of Pharmacists. Now, after a delay of more than four (04) years, when even a civil suit would be barred, the present petition has been filed. That apart, the selected candidates also have not been impleaded.

In view of above, no case for interference in the present writ petition is made out, the same is '**dismissed**'.
