Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the action of the respondents in not granting increment on their promotion as Sub Divisional Officer admissible to them as per Rule 4.4 of Civil Services Rule Vol. I, Part – I and Rule 13 of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 and further a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of one increment to them on their promotion as SDO as the promoted post carries higher responsibilities than those attaching to permanent post from which they were promoted and to pay them the arrears with interest from the date due till the date of payment.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though a legal notice was made to respondent No.1 on 31.05.2018 (P-3) but till date no conscious decision has been taken thereof. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-3), within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 31.05.2018 (P-3) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
