This is a writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notice under Section 13 (2) and notices under Section 13 (4) dated 08.09.2015 and 12.09.2015 (Annexure P-2 to P-4) under Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act 2002 against the property of the petitioner as per the detail given in advertisement published in two daily newspapers by which symbolic possession was taken and quashing of order dated 19.04.2017 passed by learned ADC, Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) vide which the possession of the property of the petitioner has been ordered to be taken with the help of police on 11.07.2018 and the same being wrong, illegal, unjust and arbitrary.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions from the petitioner to withdraw the present petition. In view thereof, he submits that the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn
