1. In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged award passed by Labour Court dated 13.08.2013 (Annexure P/6).
2. Petitioner has worked with respondent during the period from 1993 to 1994. Whereas in her claim statement, she has stated that she has worked upto 1996. Contrary material have been placed on record before the Labour Court which have been taken note of in para nos. 9, 10 and 13 in the award. Petitioner has not approached Court with clean hands and so also not giving the factual aspects relating to discharging duties of the post in Haryana Co-operative Sugar Mill, Rohtak. Thus, petitioner is not entitled to any relief. No interference is called for.
3. Petition stands dismissed.
