JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Father of the petitioner-Kulwinder Singh while working as Chowkidar reached the age of superannuation of 60 years and stood retired. He was granted extension in service for one year in view of the optional Policy during which he died on 25.10.2015. The claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been declined vide the impugned order dated 21.04.2017 (P-5).

After hearing Counsel for the petitioner, no ground for invoking the writ jurisdiction is made out as the benefit of compassionate appointment on account of death of parent during the period of extension is not covered by any Policy. For a short period a Policy dated 27.12.2016 had come about providing for such consideration, however, same stood withdrawn vide subsequent letter dated 29.03.2017. Thus, neither on the

petitioner any Policy existed providing for compassionate appointment in view of the death of a parent during period of extension of service after reaching the age of superannuation.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
