When the matter came up for hearing on 09.07.2018, this
Court passed the following order:

“Contends that in the absence of actual or deemed vacancy as defined in Para.5 of the Transfer Policy w.e.f. 15.03.2018 read with Para.2(vii), the impugned order of transfer qua the petitioner is not sustainable. Respondent No.4 – Sunita Khanna has been transferred ‘on self request against the vacancy’ from Government ITI Gulha Chika to Government ITI Ambala Cantt while the petitioner at Sr.No.2 of the impugned order dated 21.06.2018 has been transferred from Government ITI Ambala Cantt to Government ITI Gulha Chika vice respondent No.4 in public interest. The petitioner has been serving for the last 3 ½ years as Group Instructor in Government ITI Ambala

Cantt and the normal tenure is 5 years as per aforesaid

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and waives service on them. Mr. Mehta to supply requisite number of paper-books in the office of the Advocate General, Haryana with an advance copy to Mr. Rathee during the course of the day.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.4 only for 19.07.2018.

Mr. Rathee appears to inform the Court that the impugned transfer order has been withdrawn vide order dated 10.07.2018 rendering this petition infructuous. The petitioner has got his relief as prayed.
