The petitioner is engaged in the business of providing stage carriage services on various routes in the State of Punjab. The route permits have been granted by the State of Punjab under the Scheme formulated as per Motor Vehicles Act. The petitioner alleges that motor vehicles tax on its three route permits has been levied contrary to the provisions of Punjab Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1924 and the amount recovered from it qua these three route permits is liable to be refunded. Such a claim has been raised by the petitioner vide legal notice dated 20.06.2018 (P-7).

In this view of the matter and without expressing any views on merits of the petitioner's claim, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the petitioner's claim as contained in the above-mentioned legal notice, by way of speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
