The petitioner is aggrieved by the action of the respondent-authorities as the petition filed under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land (Regulation) Act, 1961 for ejectment of the private respondents on the land in dispute was allowed and no appeal was filed against the order of ejectment, but no action has been taken to eject the private respondents, who are in illegal possession of the Panchayat land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Panchayat is also in connivance with the private respondents and not interested in taking action in pursuance of order of ejectment. Petitioner has also made representation to the respondent-authorities. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to the respondent-authorities to decide the pending representation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to take action on representation dated 30.08.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
