**JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)**

By filing this civil writ petition, the petitioner *inter alia* seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 17.12.2012 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No.2.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned order is non-speaking and cryptic one.

Learned State counsel candidly acknowledges that the order passed by respondent No.2 is cryptic.

Heard.

This Court is of the opinion that the impugned order Annexure P-12 is absolutely cryptic, non-speaking and cannot be said to be an order in the eyes of law. Accordingly, order, Annexure P-12 is quashed. The respondent No.2 is directed to treat the present petition as a representation and to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner

within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioner is at par with other Craft Instructors, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
