By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 15.02.2017 (P-5) passed by respondent No.2 and to grant the benefit of deemed date of seniority as SSA in compliance of letter dated 09.07.2016 (P-3) along with further promotion to the post of J.E. notionally, with all other consequential benefits arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated 28.03.2017 (P-6) was made to the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He feels satisfied in case a

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direction is issued to the respondents to consider the claim putforth by the petitioner in his representation dated 28.03.2017 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision, in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 28.03.2017 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved any of the order(s) passed by the competent authorities, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
