RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the respondents-Central Board of Secondary Education to correct his mother's name from "Ramandeep Kaur" to "Ramandip Kaur" in the class 10th Certificates.

2. To support his case, the petitioner annexed copies of Passport wherein his mother's name is mentioned as "Ramandip Kaur". There is no need of any affidavit of petitioner's mother since there is only a clerical mistake in her name.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is allowed. The respondent-CBSE is directed to issue fresh certificates in respect of Secondary School Examination (10th) to the petitioner after correcting his mother's name from "Ramandeep Kaur" to "Ramandip Kaur". The fresh certificates be delivered upon return of old certificates to the CBSE. The necessary exercise be completed within fortnight from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. Needless to say that the CBSE while issuing fresh/corrected educational certificates will record in the certificates that '*the correction*
