By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant them the benefit of interim relief, in view of the letter/order dated February 16, 2017 (P-5) issued by the Government, especially in view of the order dated September 09, 2010 (P-4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated May 15, 2018 (P-6) within some stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the above said legal notice dated May 15, 2018 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a

speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
