There does not seem to be any palpable error or misdemeanor in the conduct of the selection process leading to the appointment of the third respondent as Supervisor Female in the Women & Child Welfare Department, Haryana.

The petitioner applied under the General category. She was interviewed on 25.06.2009, but her name did not figure in the selection list. The result was declared on 04.10.2013. She was placed at Sr.No.2 of the waiting list, whereas the private respondent was at Sr.No.1.

Few posts in the Ex-servicemen (General) category remained unfilled, which were diverted to General category and that is how one vacancy was offered to the third respondent being at Sr.No.1 in the waiting list. In any case, the waiting list is not a perennial source of recruitment and vacancy whether original or diverted have to be filled according to advertised number. No mala fides have been alleged against any person

including the members of the Commission in this petition filed in the year 2013.

For the reasons recorded above, interference is not warranted and accordingly the petition is dismissed.
