By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner of Punjabi/SST teacher against 5178 posts duly advertised in the year 2012 (Annexure P-6) being qualified for the post having secured 52.9416 marks from SC (R&O) category whereas the candidates securing lesser marks have been included in the merit list.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-Director, Education Recruitment Directorate Punjab Government (Model) Senior Secondary School (Microsoft Building) Phase-3B1, Mohali is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.11.2017 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.3-Director, Education Recruitment Directorate Punjab Government (Model) Senior Secondary School (Microsoft Building) Phase-3B1, Mohali to consider and decide the legal notice dated 17.11.2017 (Annexure P-17) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
