RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

This petition is filed against the order dated 24.05.2018 by which request made by the petitioner for correction in his name and his parents' name in his educational certificates has been declined.

In brief, the petitioner is a minor. His father Shaik Abdul Moluali is a Subedar in Army Medical Corps and was posted as JCO at Bathinda. The petitioner got admission in Class IXth & Xth at Army Public School, Bathinda. While filling up Class Xth Form-2017 for taking the examination of the CBSE, the petitioner used his short name as 'S.A. Jubed' instead of his full name as 'Shaik Abdul Jubed'. He also mentioned name of his father in short as 'S.A. Moluali' whereas full name of his father is 'Shaik Abdul Molulai' and his mother's name as 'S.A. Rokia Bibi' instead of 'Rokhia Bibi'.

It is submitted that the petitioner belongs to Andhara Pradesh and has mentioned 'S.A.' before the name of his mother as well, whereas

S.A. stands for 'Shaik Abdul'.

The prayer made by the petitioner for making the necessary correction in his educational certificates has been declined by the impugned order dated 24.05.2018 on the ground that correction is not permissible as per Rule 69.1(i) (ii) of Examination Bye-laws of the CBSE.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon a decision of this Court rendered in the case of **Uday Goel vs. Central Board of Secondary Education**, CWP No.29565 of 2017, decided on 23.02.2018, in which a similar controversy was involved. It is submitted that in other documents like Adhaar Card and Birth Certificate etc., name of the petitioner and his parents are mentioned correctly.

Thus, keeping in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and while relying upon the judgment of this Court rendered in **Uday Goel's case (supra)**, the present petition is hereby allowed and the respondents are directed to carry out necessary corrections in petitioner's name and in the name of his parents in all his educational certificates and issue all revised educational certificates to the petitioner bearing his full name as well as full name of his parents, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
