The petitioner was allotted a multi-storied apartment by the Housing Board, Haryana vide allotment letter dated 19.01.2014. The cost of the apartment was enhanced by the Housing Board which the petitioner did not want to pay and surrendered the flat within the time given to him. He sought refund of the amount vide representation-cum-letter dated 10.11.2016 (P-3) and gave a reminder on 10.01.2016 followed by a legal notice dated 05.02.2018, but finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the above-mentioned claim of the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
