Petitioner filed the instant petition praying for Mandamus for directing the respondents to declare the result of the D.P.C proceedings held on 25.1.2016 for the post of Executive Engineer in the Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board and which had been kept in sealed cover only on the ground of pendency of an earlier writ petition filed by the petitioner i.e. CWP-21734-2008.

It has gone uncontroverted that after filing of the instant writ petition order dated 9.7.2018 was passed and in terms of which petitioner was promoted to the post of Executive Engineer w.e.f. 29.1.2016 i.e. the date her juniors were so promoted.

The only issue that survived in the petition was that inspite of the promotion order dated 9.7.2018, pay had not been fixed on the promotional post and even arrears for the period 29.1.2016 to 9.7.2018 had not been released.

Counsel for the petitioner informs the Court today that pay of the petitioner on the promotional post of Executive Engineer has since been

fixed and even the arrears for the period in question have been released.

Counsel representing the respondent-Board also affirms such factual premise.

In view of the above, nothing would survive in the instant writ petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Pending applications, if any, would also stand disposed of.
