The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Staff Nurse. Pursuant to an order dated 21.08.2017, the respondents were directed to scrutinize her documents subject to the final result in the petition. Today, learned State counsel has produced the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover as also the records that show that the last candidate in the category of the petitioner i.e. Scheduled Caste, has since obtained 70 marks. Whereas, the petitioner had secured 64 marks i.e. 54 in the written examination and 10 in interview. Thus, she failed to qualify for selection.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner, who is being shown the records, submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
