JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

Through the instant petition, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical bills amounting to ₹1,15,213/- in respect of his wife.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner incurred a sum of ₹1,15,213/- on the medical treatment of his wife and accordingly, medical bills were submitted for the reimbursement thereof, to the office of Civil Surgeon, Moga and as per the affidavit a payment to the tune of ₹84,707/- has been already been made strictly in accordance with policy issued by the Director Health & Family Welfare, Punjab Chandigarh dated February 13, 1994 (R-1). The afore-said amount stood disbursed to the petitioner.

3. In the light of afore-said narrated facts and circumstances, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is dismissed, as such. However, in case the petitioner still feels aggrieved he shall have the liberty to have recourse to the remedies available to him under law.
