AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the petition bearing No.P/Coop/07 of 2018 filed by the petitioner under Section 27 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984, wherein challenge has been made to the appointment of respondent No.3, Laxman Dass Goel, as Chief Accounts Officer, Sugar Mills, Palwal.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that in the impugned resolution, the appointment of respondent No.3 is only for a period of one year and in case the petition of the petitioner is not considered and decided, the very purpose of filing the same shall be frustrated. Referring to the zimni orders, which have been passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies as reproduced in Para 11, he contends that the case is not being taken up for hearing because of one reason or the other.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the appointment of respondent No.3 is limited for a period of one year and if the petition is not heard and decided at an early date, the very purpose of filing the same would stand frustrated, direction is issued to the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, Panchkula (respondent No.1) to consider the petition of the petitioner and finalize the same within a period of two months from the next date of hearing, which is fixed before respondent No.1 i.e. 26.07.2018.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
