This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wage service of the petitioners rendered before their respective regularization as qualifying service and permit the petitioners to continue on the old GPF scheme.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that case of the petitioners is covered by a judgment passed by Division Bench of this Court in CWP-2371-2010 titled as “**Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others**” decided on 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-3). Further, he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) in view of Annexure P-3.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) in view of Annexure P-3 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
