Earlier, the instant petition has been dismissed for non-prosecution and in default of appearance on 16.05.2017. Thereafter, the petitioner moved an application for recall of the order dated 16.05.2017, which was also dismissed vide order dated 23.03.2018 for want of maintainability when not accompanied by an application for condoning the delay. Ultimately, the petitioner moved application for restoration of petition along with application for condonation of delay of 342 days in filing the application. Both the applications were allowed vide order dated 02.07.2018 and the case was ordered to be restored to its original number.

On the previous date i.e. 27.07.2018, the case was adjourned for today i.e. 30.10.2018 on the request made on behalf of the petitioner.

However, it was made clear that no further adjournment shall be given for the purpose. Today, no one appears for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution and in default of appearance. The Registry will not entertain any application in this case until it is accompanied by receipt of deposit of ₹25,000/- in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre attached to this Court.
