1. This order will dispose of both the petitions.
2. The contractual period of service by the petitioners as Computer Operators/Data Entry Operators in these two cases was extended for a period of six months each till 28.02.2019 through outsourcing agency, namely, HARTRON on the same terms and

conditions already stipulated in the letter dated 19.08.2013. Office order dated 30.03.2018 extending the contract in the cases of 12 employees which include the petitioners and the order of sanction dated 01.10.2018 issued by the Chairman of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Panchkula has been produced in Court today. The same are retained on record.

3. In view of these office orders, the petitioners continue in service on contract basis and therefore both the petitions are disposed of as premature.

4. In case the Board contemplates terminating the services of the petitioners on the expiry of the contract, then it will give them an advance notice of one month to enable them to approach Court with their grievance.
