1. The petitioner, by way of public interest litigation filed under

Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, order or directing the respondents No. 1 to 4 to take an appropriate legal action against the respondent no.5 and for including removal/relocation of respondent no.5 as per law for causing pollution in the residential locality as against the law.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Surinder Singh Mathru, Environmental Engineer, Punjab Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Patiala on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.
3. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the status report on behalf of respondent no.2 filed in Court today, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to pursue other remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
