Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned action of the respondent-Bank in making the recovery of the amount of Leave Travel Concession paid to them and to refund the same along with interest @ 12% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though various representations dated 02.08.2011, 15.04.2013 & 23.02.2015 (P-7 colly) were made to the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said representations has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department. He further submits that they feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said representations within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the representations dated 02.08.2011, 15.04.2013 & 23.02.2015 (P-7 colly) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with judgment already rendered by this Court in CWP No.23198 of 2015, captioned as ***Khazan Chand & ors. vs. State of Punjab & ors.*** decided on 06.10.2017 (P-9), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
