Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to implement the transfer order dated 13.01.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.4, vide which, he (petitioner) has been transferred from Chandigarh to Hisar.

While issuing notice of motion in this case on 23.08.2017, the petitioner was allowed to continue at Hisar.

The petitioner has been posted in Chandigarh for the last four years and thereafter, he was transferred to Hisar vide order dated 11/13.01.2017 (Annexure P-1). He was relieved vide order dated 20.06.2017. Subsequently, he joined at Hisar on 21.06.2017 (Annexure P-3). However, his transfer order has been cancelled vide impugned order dated 10.08.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed. Along with the reply, they have placed on record copy of order dated 05.03.2018 (Annexure R-1), whereby the petitioner, Conductor No.262, was allowed to join his duty on 24.08.2017 and was allotted Conductor No.126,

at Hisar. It is further stated that in the Commercial Officer's meeting of Transport Department held on 10.05.2018 under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, it has been decided that new transfer policy has been finalized, which will be implemented soon.

In view of the said fact, no further direction is required to be issued in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner can avail the remedy by making appropriate application, if need be.
