This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of ₹60,50,000/- along with security qua the works, which were allotted to the petitioner.

In the year 2016, the petitioner was allotted certain works by the respondents, details of which have been given in para No.2 of the petition. The petitioner has completed the said work(s) to the satisfaction of the respondents. But the payment and security amount of ₹60,50,000/- has not been released to him till date. In this regard, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 12.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) upon respondent No.3, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

In view of the above position, this petition, at this stage is being disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, by giving a direction to the respondents to look in to the legal notice dated

within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the respondents come to a conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the amount mentioned above, the same be released forthwith.
