The prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to rehabilitate the members of the petitioner-Union after conducting a proper survey, to set up a town vending committee and to issue the certificate of vending in strict compliance of The Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 to protect the rights of the urban street vendors and to regulate street vending.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submitted that appropriate action has been initiated by the respondent-authority and the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. Learned counsel further submitted that he has instructions to withdraw the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
