By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus direction the respondents to grant her pensionary benefits after counting work charge service w.e.f. January 01, 1978 to April 01, 1984 as qualifying service for the purpose of pension and also to release all the retiral benefits to her along-with interest 18% per annum, which was withheld due to pendency of criminal appeal CRM-A-5-MA of 2008 titled as 'State Vs. Munshi Ram, before this Court and now the appeal has become infructuous due to the death of Mushi Ram.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a legal notice dated July 29, 2017 (P-6) was served upon the respondents but it did not fetch any reply. He further submits that he feels

satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the afore-said notice within some time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to disposed of the legal notice (P-6) in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by Government from time to time within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the concerned authority disagrees with various submissions made by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-6), to pass a speaking order and in that event, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
