The petitioner is seeking the evaluation of the answer key of the Punjab State Teacher Eligibility Test held on 13.12.2015.

The petitioner belongs to the reserved category. She had appeared in the Punjab State Teacher Eligibility Test on 13.12.2015. Her result was declared on 21.12.2015 in which she had secured 79 marks out of 150. In order to be eligible, she required 82 marks and was short by 3 marks. She has challenged the answer key of the questions No.40, 47, 50, 53, 58 & 60 of booklet Series-I of the said test.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly admitted that an opportunity was granted to her by respondent No.3 to raise objection to the correctness of the answer key but the said opportunity was not availed by her and has now filed the writ petition after almost 2 years.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusal of the available record, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner is not entitled to the prayer made in this petition because she was granted an opportunity to raise the objection about the correctness of the answer key

which she did not avail and the present petition has been filed after a long delay of more than 2 years, after the declaration of result, and thus suffers from delay and latches as well.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed though without any order as to cost.
