Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent to grant him promotion on the post of Chief Engineer from the date of his junior is promoted with all consequential benefits including arrears along with interest @ 18% p.a.

2. File perused.

3. A perusal of the file transpires that petitioner has already served representation dated 04.06.2018 (P-14) upon the respondent but neither the respondent has responded to the aforesaid representation (P-14) nor taken any conscious decision. So in the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that instant petition can be conveniently disposed of by giving a direction to the respondent to take a conscious decision within some stipulated period.

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4. Accordingly, without expressing anything on merits but considering the inaction on the parts of the respondent, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 04.06.2018 (P-14) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved against any order passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
