By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned office order No.69 dated 16.08.2013 (Annexure P-2/T), passed by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner was illegally dismissed from service.

Heard.

As per reply, the impugned office order No. 69 dated 16.08.2013 (Annexure P-2/T), passed by respondent No.2 stands withdrawn and the petitioner has been allowed to join duty on 01.07.2015. However, the petitioner was found guilty during the enquiry and lesser punishment of stoppage of one annual increment with future effect has been imposed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that

though the petitioner has been reinstated, however, the reinstatement order is silent about the subsistence allowance and how the period during which the petitioner remained out of job has been treated.

As the substantial relief has been allowed to the petitioner, therefore, the present petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move a representation for redressal of his grouse, if so advised.
