The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions to the respondent to open the financial bid submitted by the petitioner in the event of the technical bid was found technically qualified in pursuance to the Notice Inviting Tender dated 12.07.2017 for appointment of Contractors at HAIC Ware Houses at Shahbad (M), Pipli and Jind. Further prayer has been made for restraining the respondent from allocating the work to any other bidder other than the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent stated that appointment of Contractors at HAIC Ware Houses at Shahbad (M) and Pipli had been finalized by *inter se bidding* in the open Court vide order dated 11.10.2017 passed by this Court.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner did not dispute this
fact.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent further stated that
in pursuant to order dated 11.10.2017, fresh tenders had been
invited in the month of April, 2018 as regards HAIC Warehouse at
Jind to avoid multiplicity of litigation and in the public interest.
However, the same has not been finalized so far.

5. Accordingly, counsel for the petitioner states that
nothing survives in the present writ petition and the same may be
disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. Ordered accordingly.
