Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that against the ex parte order passed by the Commissioner Hissar Division, Hissar setting aside the well reasoned and detailed orders passed by the two Courts below, which were in favour of the petitioners, a revision petition No. 289 of 2017 has been preferred by the petitioners which is pending with the Financial Commissioner Revenue Haryana-respondent No.1-A since 28.02.2018 in which not even a preliminary hearing has taken place and thus virtually rendering the petitioners remedy less.

In case assertion made by the counsel for the petitioners as recorded above is found correct, then the Financial Commissioner Revenue Haryana- respondent No.1-A, shall consider the revision petition and pass

appropriate orders in accordance with law on the next date of hearing i.e.
06.08.2018.
