Petitioner is stated to have been promoted as Soil Conservator/Ranger Officer and posted at Badla Range (Dasuya Branch), District Hoshiarpur, since 12.07.2017. He has challenged the order dated 27.06.2018 (P-2) whereby Reet Mohinder Pal Singh, respondent no.4 working as Forester has been posted as Incharge of the Forest Range Badla i.e. in place of the petitioner.

Upon notice, reply dated 15.11.2018 on behalf of the official respondent nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court. In reply it is stated that petitioner has not been transferred from his place of posting and, therefore, no cause of action has accrued. It is further stated that respondent no.4 has
