Petitioners are working on Class-IV posts in the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab. The promotion from Class-IV (Group-D) posts is provided to the post of Clerk by providing 15% promotional quota under The Punjab Medical Department Subordinate Posts (Recruitment & Conditions) Rules 1945 supplemented by instructions dated 23.12.2014 (P-2). One of the mandatory qualification is the passing of Computer typing test in English and Punjabi of required standards.

The grievance of the petitioners is that inspite of the posts available in the promotional quota, the prescribed typing test is not being conducted by the Department.

Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapoor, Additional Advocate General, Punjab was directed to verify the factual position on the last date of hearing.

Today she on instructions from Ms. Perminder Kaur, Senior

Assistant, office of Director Health and Family Welfare, Punjab states that the 1945 Rules are in the process of being updated by new Rules which are under the process of final approval. She however, states that the Department is in the process of conducting the required typing test in English and Punjabi so as to determine the suitability of the employees like the petitioner. She further states that in all probability within next two months the type test would be conducted.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the State through its Counsel, nothing more survives for adjudication in the present writ petition. Respondents hopefully shall do the needful within the next two months.

Disposed of in the above terms.
