At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners points-out that there is a typographical mistake in the memo of parties as petitioner No.16 has been wrongly mentioned as son of Hoshiar Singh, whereas she is daughter of Hoshiar Singh.

Registry is directed to carry out necessary correction in the memo of parties.

The land of the petitioners' father situated within the revenue estate of Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar was statedly acquired vide Award dated 24.04.1998. The petitioners are said to have applied on 23.03.2017 for allotment of plots under the Oustees Policy in lieu of the acquisition of their land. Since no action appears to have been taken on their applications and their claim under the Oustees Policy is still under consideration, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any views on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to ascertain the correct facts

and decide the petitioners' claim as contained in the above-mentioned legal notice dated 23.03.2017, in accordance with the HUDA Policy within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
